

The 7th Global Conference on Economic Geography

Travel Grant Application

The Organising Committee announces the availability of travel grants to help cover the costs of participation in the GCEG 4-8th June 2025 in Worcester, Massachusetts. A total of 15 travel grants will be awarded competitively to applicants. A preference will be given to graduate students, postdoctoral researchers, and other early career applicants. The following travel grants are available for application for early career-scholars (graduate students or post-docs) travelling long distances and/or from the Global South.:

- 5 x \$1000 from *Economic Geography* (Clark University/Taylor and Francis).
- 5 x \$1000 from *EPA: Economy and Space* (SAGE).
- 5 X \$1000 from *Geoforum* (Elsevier).

Additionally, the Organising Committee will bear the registration fees for the selected travel grant holders. Because the funds available are limited (a lump sum), the successful applicants will be required to meet some of the costs of participation. Please see application form below.

To apply for a GCEG travel grant, the following documents should be submitted by **January 7, 2025** to clark@gceg.org:

- completed application form (see below).
- a motivation letter (one page maximum length) describing why you would like to participate in the GCEG.
- a curriculum vitae (two pages maximum length), including a short list of publications (maximum total of 10 publications).
- a support statement from your supervisor (for PhD candidates only).
- an abstract of your paper for the GCEG.

Only completed applications will be accepted. The final decision on the distribution of funds, and of the funding awarded to each successful applicant, lies with the sponsors of the grants and is subject to the availability of funds. All applicants will be notified of the outcome of the selection procedure by February 1, 2025. They will then be asked to submit their abstract via the online system by February 11, 2025 in order to be assured of funding support.
